
Student Symptom Decision Tree Low-risk: general symptoms High-risk: red flag symptoms Fever (≥100.4°F) Sore throat Cough **Difficulty breathing** Congestion/runny nose Headache Nausea/vomiting/diarrhea Fatigue/muscle Loss of taste/smell or body aches Symptomatic and exposure to a COVID-19 positive person? within 6 ft of a COVID + or clinically compatible person for >15 min in a 24 hr period, regardless of masking Return to school 24 hrs NO Send home ▶1 low risk symptom after symptom resolution (without fever reducing medication) **▶≥2 low risk symptoms** Evaluation by Send home health care provider OR 1 high risk symptom Health care provider confirms alternative diagnosis for symptoms. A health care Return to school after 24 hrs without fever provider's note must be on file. and symptoms improving Certified SARS-CoV-2 PCR or Antigen Test not needed Return to school after 24 hrs without fever Negative certified SARS-CoV-2 PCR or Antigen Test and symptoms improving Return to school only after 10 days since Positive certified SARS-CoV-2 PCR symptom onset and 24 hrs without fever. or Antigen Test Quarantine close contacts of confirmed No provider visit or test. cases. Face covering (well-fitting and used correctly) on BOTH infected and exposed person




Symptoms develop ••••

Modified 10-day quarantine while attending school in-person if:

- Wears a mask (inside and outside)
- Tests 2x per week for the 10 days, at least 3 days apart
- · Quarantine from any extra-curricular activity for 14 days
- May return to school after 7 days if test (-) after 5 days from last exposure (may begin extra-curriculars as well)
- No face covering on EITHER infected or exposed person

Symptoms

- Isolation for 10 days regardless of test results
- Get tested
- Get care



from last exposure (if not tested) OR May return to school after 7 days if test negative after 5 days from last exposure (may begin extra-curriculars as well)

Home self-quarantine until after 10 days
